## Air Canada adds daily flight at Deer Lake

**April 5, 2011 Deer Lake, NL** The Deer Lake Regional Airport will get a little busier with the addition of a new daily flight to and from St. John's beginning May 2, 2011.

The new flight will be operated by Air Canada's commercial partner Exploit's Valley Air Services (EVAS) using an 18-seat Beech 1900 aircraft. The flight is scheduled to depart St. John's at 12:25 p.m. and arrive in Deer Lake at 1:35 p.m. It will then depart Deer Lake at 2:00 p.m. and arrive in St. John's at 3:05 p.m.

The additional daily service was welcome news for the Deer Lake Regional Airport Authority. "We are pleased that Air Canada has added a new mid day service to complement its early morning and evening departures", said Jamie Schwartz, Airport Chief Executive Officer. "This new flight provides the traveling public with another service and extends the list of travel options available to the public at the Deer Lake Regional Airport", added Schwartz.

The Deer Lake Regional Airport provides regular or seasonal domestic and charter passenger services with several airlines including Air Canada, Air Canada Jazz, Canadian North, Provincial Airlines, Sunwing and WestJet.
