Sunwing Airlines adds service to Deer Lake

February 23, 2007 Deer Lake, NL. Sunwing Airlines has announced a new weekly summer service direct from Deer Lake to Toronto from June 28 – September 6, 2007. Sunwing will utilize its new generation Boeing 737-800 aircraft with a capacity for 189 passengers.

This new passenger service to and from Toronto follows recent announcements by the two major national carriers to add a direct Deer Lake to Toronto service. Air Canada will commence its new daily direct service to and from Toronto on May 4 and WestJet will launch its new daily direct service to and from Toronto on May 14.

Jamie Schwartz, Airport Manager, welcomed the new service announcement by Sunwing. “This new service clearly demonstrates the airline industry has tremendous confidence in the regional marketplace,” said Schwartz. “Our summer flight schedule offers a significant increase in capacity and competition and this should benefit our local population as well as the Western Newfoundland tourism industry,” added Schwartz.

The Deer Lake Regional Airport serves Western Newfoundland with twenty regularly scheduled flights each day to destinations including St. John’s, Goose Bay, Halifax, Montreal and Toronto with connections worldwide. Air Canada, Air Canada Jazz, Air Labrador and Provincial Airlines now offer a regular service to and from Deer Lake. The Airport also provides a winter and summer seasonal international charter service to and from the United Kingdom.
